PIRACY AND ARMED ROBBERY AGAINST SHIPS

1 Lately, there were a number of incidents involving armed robbers/criminals attacking ships and taking one or more of the ship's personnel as hostages in the northern part of the Malacca Strait.

2 In the latest incident on 14 Mar 05, a group of armed robbers/criminals boarded a tug towing a barge in the same area and took away three crewmembers as hostages.

3 Mariners navigating in the Malacca and Singapore Straits are advised to exercise extra vigilance and to have in place measures on preventing and suppressing acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships. For guidance, please refer to IMO MSC Circular 623/Rev.3, which was attached to Port Marine Circular No. 31 of 2003.

4 In the event of an attack or suspicious movements are identified which may result in an imminent attack, shipmasters are advised to report to the nearest coastal state authorities and/or the relevant Rescue Co-ordination Centre (RCC) for the area.

5 For reports of incidents in the Singapore Strait, shipmasters are advised to report to the Singapore Authorities as follows:
