AUTHORISATION TO EXTEND EXPIRED CERTIFICATES

[21st May 1976]

The Minister for Communications has authorised —

(a) the Director of Marine and all officers in the Foreign Service who are performing consular functions abroad to extend the validity of any expired certificates; and

(b) the organisations set out in the Schedule to extend the validity of expired Cargo Ship Safety Construction Certificates,

under Regulation 14 (*d*) and (*f*) of Chapter I of the Merchant Shipping (Safety Convention) Regulations.
