

TRAINING PATH FOR SCHOLARSHIP HOLDER ATTENDING THE DIPLOMA IN MARINE ENGINEERING COURSE (DMR)

Phase of Training	Description of Training	Tuition/Uniform/Book/Training Allowances payable
Phase I (3 years)	Attends the 3-year Diploma in Marine Engineering Course conducted at the Singapore Maritime Academy (SMA), a department of the Singapore Polytechnic.	a) Tuition Fee for Diploma in Marine Engineering Course; b) Uniform/Book Allowance - \$300 per year. c) Training allowance during Marine Engineering Course at \$900 x 36 months = \$32,400.
Phase II (6 months)	Undergoes 6 months shipboard training as an Assistant Engineer on board a vessel operated by the Employer and sit for oral examination of Class 5 Engineer Officer Certificate of Competency (COC) conducted by Director of Marine, Singapore.	a) Training allowance during shipboard training as an assistant engineer at \$900 x 6 months = \$5,400.
Enlists for National Service for 2 years (if applicable)		
Phase III (18 months)	Works as a Watchkeeping Engineer Officer for 18 months on board vessel operated by Employer.	As a Watchkeeping Engineer Officer, a monthly basic salary of about \$1,600 is payable.
Phase IV (5 months)	Attends 5-month Combined Class 1 & 2 Engineer Officer Certificate of Competency Preparatory Course conducted by SMA and sits for written and oral examinations of Class 2 Engineer Officer COC conducted by Director of Marine, Singapore	a) Tuition fee for Combined Class 1 & 2 Engineer Officer Preparatory Course. b) Uniform/Book Allowance - \$300. c) Training allowance during the Combined Class 1 & 2 Engineer Officer Course at \$900 x 5 months = \$4,500.

- NOTES:**
- i) After obtaining the Class 2 Marine Engineer Officer COC, the scholarship holder will have to work on board ship as a Watchkeeping Engineer Officer for another 18 months to be eligible to sit for the Class 1 Marine Engineer Officer COC Examination conducted by the Director of Marine.
 - ii) A Marine Engineer Officer holding a Class 2 COC can earn a starting monthly basic salary of about \$3,400.
 - iii) A Marine Engineer Officer holding a Class 1 COC can earn a starting monthly basic salary of about \$5,000.
 - iv) A Marine Engineer Officer holding a Class 1 COC and employed as a Chief Engineer of a ship can earn a starting monthly basic salary of about \$6,000.
