

# LNG BUNKERING PILOT PROGRAMME IN SINGAPORE

## REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

### Objective

The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) invites interested parties to submit applications for the LNG Bunker supplier licence via a Request for Proposal (“RFP”). The licence would allow the licensee to supply LNG bunker to vessels in the Port of Singapore. Successful applicants are expected to supply LNG bunker to support the LNG bunkering Pilot Programme that is scheduled to commence in early 2017.

Applicants should propose an end-to-end LNG bunkering supply solution that details, amongst other things, their bunkering supply and delivery model, their LNG sources and their marketing plans for the sale of LNG to customers in the Port of Singapore.
