MARINE SOIL INVESTIGATION AND SURVEY WORKS AT TEMASEK FAIRWAY

Details

: Soil investigation works will be carried out using one jack-up barge per location. Two tugs will be deployed to assist the positioning of the jack-up barge. The barge with tugboat in attendance will require a safe working zone of 30 meters radius centered at the barge.

A safety boat will be deployed to warn other craft in the vicinity of the working area.
