CRANE BARGE OVERNIGHT STAYING AT PULAU SATUMU

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Date : With effect from 12 Sep 2026 to 18 Sep 2026.

This craft will exhibit the appropriate local and international day and night signals.

Details : The crane barge is required to remain anchored overnight off Pulau Satumu due to the presence of complex lifting equipment and installed machinery that are sensitive to repeated mobilization.
