TRANSPORT OF SAND MATERIAL AT TUAS VIEW EXTENSION

Applicable to: Mariners operating off West of Tuas View Extension

This PMN supersedes Port Marine Notice No. 34 of 2025. The working period has been extended, the work scope, list of craft and chartlet have been revised.

Details : The work involves transporting and dumping of sand material with the use of hopper barges and dredgers to the stockpile area. Marine Cone Penetration Tests will also be conducted at the stockpile area.

A safety boat will be deployed to warn other craft in the vicinity of the working area.
