CLOSURE OF ST JOHN'S ISLAND JETTY AND KUSU ISLAND BUMBOAT JETTY

Applicable to: Visitors embarking or disembarking at St. John's Island Jetty and Kusu Island Bumboat Jetty.

This PMN supersedes Port Marine Notice No. 48 of 2025. The working period has been extended.

<u>Date</u>: With effect from 23 Sep 2025 to 23 Mar 2026.

<u>Details</u>: St John's Island jetty and Kusu Island bumboat jetty will be temporarily

closed from the date stated, subject to extension.

All crafts and visitors are advised not to embark/disembark at St John's Island jetty and Kusu Island bumboat jetty during the closure.

St John's Island and Kusu Island remain accessible to the public via alternative jetties. Visitors can access St John's Island and Kusu Island via Seringat jetty and Kusu Island main jetty, respectively.

The maximum loading capacity of Seringat Jetty is 150 tonnes.
