#### **DREDGING WORKS AT GUL BASIN**

Applicable to: Mariners operating in the vicinity of ST Gul Yard

<u>Date</u>: With effect from 15 Dec 2025 to 30 Apr 2026.

Working Hours : 24 hours daily, including Sundays and public holidays.

<u>Craft</u>: Please refer to **ANNEX A** for the list of craft approved for

deployment in the working area.

These craft will exhibit the appropriate local and international day

and night signals.

Details : The work involves using a clamshell dredger to dredge the seabed

and load the spoils into flat-top barges.

The clamshell dredger will be secured by 4-point anchor mooring. The anchor will be marked with flashing anchor buoys. Tugboats will be deployed to manoeuvre the barges in and out of the working

area.

Dredged spoils from the working area will be loaded into a hopper barge. Once fully loaded, the hopper barge will travel from the working area to the designated dumping ground via the approved

dumping route, assisted by a pusher tugboat.

The above process will continue until the completion of the

dredging works.

A safety boat will be deployed to warn other craft in the vicinity of

the working area.
