DREDGING WORKS AT GUL BASIN

Applicable to: Mariners operating in the vicinity of ST Gul Yard

Date : With effect from 15 Dec 2025 to 30 Apr 2026.

Location : At sea, within the working area bound by the following co-ordinates

- Working Hours : 24 hours daily, including Sundays and public holidays.
- Craft : Please refer to **ANNEX A** for the list of crafts approved for deployment in the working area.
- These crafts will exhibit the appropriate local and international day and night signals.
- Details : The work involves using a clamshell dredger to dredge the seabed and load the spoils into flat-top barges.
- The clamshell dredger will be secured by 4-point anchor mooring. The anchor will be marked with flashing anchor buoys. Tugboats will be deployed to manoeuvre the barges in and out of the working area.
- Dredged spoils from the working area will be loaded into a hopper barge. Once fully loaded, the hopper barge will travel from the working area to the designated dumping ground via the approved dumping route, assisted by a pusher tugboat.
- The above process will continue until the completion of the dredging works.
- A safety boat will be deployed to warn other craft in the vicinity of the working area.
