## DREDGING WORK AT QUAY 2 AT SEATRIUM BENOI YARD

		These craft will exhibit the appropriate local and international day and night signals.				

<u>Details</u> : The work involves using a clamshell dredger (6m<sup>3</sup> or equivalent) to dredge the seabed and load the spoils into flat top barges deployed next to the dredger.

Dredging work will be carried out to the specified depth within the working area by clamshell grab dredger equipped with positioning system and secure in place by 4- point anchor moorings.

Anchors will be marked by anchor buoys with flashing lights. Steel tugboats will be deployed to shift the barges in and out of the working area.

The dredged spoils from the location Q2 will be loaded into flat top barge later berth alongside quay or slip way of shipyard, then fully loaded barge will be unloaded by excavator and transport by tipper trucks to designated stockpile area within the yard. Barges and trucks will not exit the working area.

The above process will continue until the completion of the dredging works.

A safety boat will attend at all times to warn and re-direct craft in the vicinity to keep clear of the working area.
