Working Hours : 24 hours daily including Sundays and Public Holidays.

Craft : Please refer to **ANNEX A** for the list of craft for deployment in the working area.

These craft will exhibit the appropriate local and international day and night signals.

Details : Flat top barges will be engaged for the delivery of materials from port to work site, berthed alongside with crane barge.

Temporary piles for the working platform will first be installed by vibro, and the permanent piles will be driven with a hydraulic hammer to the designed penetration and set. Piles will be stored and kept on standby on a material barge adjacent to the crane barge if required.

Crane barge will be used to hoist the piling machine and drive the permanent piles into the seabed as per the designed penetration. All piling materials will be delivered by sea to the site and lifted by the crane barge onto the work barge for installation. Access to barges will be through the existing ramp/temporary jetty to the working area by passenger/working boat. Safety evacuation shall be via temporary gangway to the same jetty access.

All the temporary work to be removed and cleared from site upon works completion

Caution : **When in the vicinity of the working area, mariners are reminded to:**

- a) **Keep well clear and not to enter the working area;**
- b) **Maintain a proper lookout;**
- c) **Proceed at a safe speed and navigate with caution;**
- d) **Maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 (East Control); and**
- e) **Communicate with East Control on VHF Channel 12 for assistance, if required.**
