MANAGEMENT OF CREW USERS' ACCOUNTS FOR SHIPPING AGENTS

- The Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) would like to inform that with effect from <u>26 Jul 2025</u>, all CREW user accounts that remain 'inactive' for consecutive 90 days or more (i.e. with no submission of crew related applications) will be automatically deactivated.

MANAGEMENT OF CREW USERS' ACCOUNTS FOR SHIPPING AGENTS

Today, shipping agents use the CREW accounts issued by ICA to submit crew/vessel related applications via the MPA's digitalPORT@SGTM system. Please be informed that all CREW accounts that are 'inactive' (i.e. with no submission of crew related applications) for 90 consecutive days or more will be automatically deactivated on **26 Jul 2025**. This would be an on-going process.

- Once the account is deactivated, the shipping agent will not be able to submit any crew/vessel related application (eg. Arrival/departure application, sign-on/sign-off application) to ICA.
- Shipping agents are strongly encouraged to login to digitalPORT@SGTM on **27 Jul 2025** to check whether their CREW accounts are still valid. If they are unable to access to the "ICA crew services module" in digitalPORT@SGTM, it would mean that their CREW accounts have been deactivated. To re-activate their CREW account, they could submit a "new account request" via digitalPORT@SGTM which is the current process.
