These craft will exhibit the appropriate local and international day and night signals.

Details : Soil investigation works will be carried out by means of borehole drilling using jack-up barge. The work barge, with tugboats in attendance, will have a circular safety working zone of 30 meters radius centred at the barge.

Tugboats will be used for shifting the barges from one borehole location to another. The shifting of the barges will be carried out during daylight hours only.

A safety boat will be deployed in the vicinity of the working area to warn other craft of the project work.
