SOIL INVESTIGATION WORKS USING VIBRO-CORE IN SINGAPORE WATER

Applicable to: Mariners operating in the Singapore water.

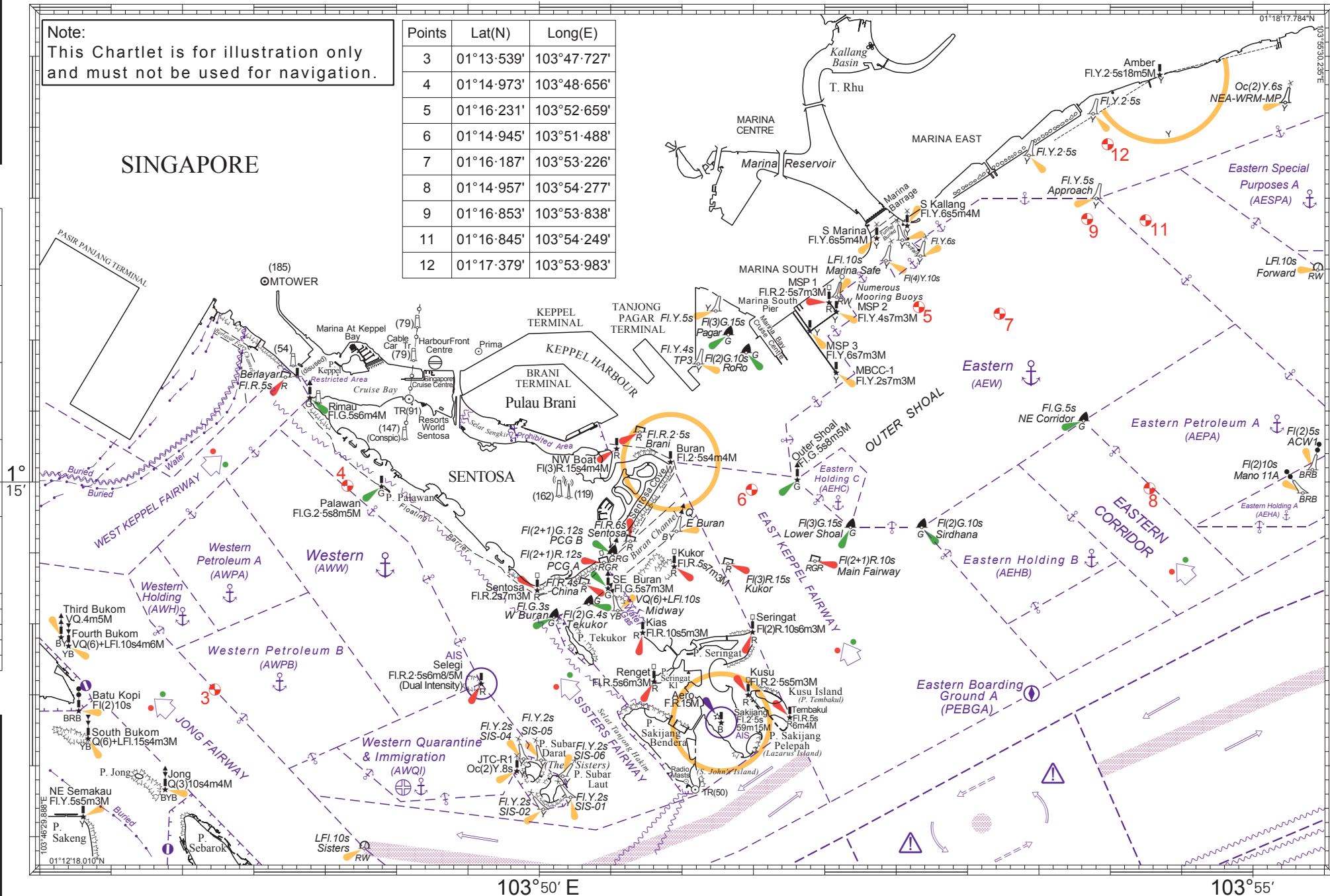
