CONTROL OF PARACHUTISTS AND HAND-GLIDING ACTIVITIES

- 1 Former Port Circular No 45 of 1988 is cancelled. This is reproduction of the circular with amendments.
- Pursuant to Regulation 53 of the Maritime And Port Authority of Singapore (Pleasure Craft) Regulations 1997 the Port Master hereby directs that no pleasure craft shall be permitted to tow parachutes or other devices used in connection with hang-gliding or other similar activities within the Port Limits of Singapore.
- Any person who contravenes the above mentioned prohibition shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding one thousand dollars for every day or part thereof during which the offence continues after conviction.
