GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICES AT ANCHORAGES IN PORT OF SINGAPORE

Applicable to: The Shipping Community and/or Ships in Singapore Port Anchorages

- 1 Currently, MPA is providing garbage collection services to all vessels at anchorages in the port of Singapore from 7.30am to 5.30pm.
- 2 To improve our service levels to the port and maritime community, MPA has embarked on an initiative known as the “E-Receipt system”. Through this initiative, shipping agents or ship masters can easily retrieve and download information from the Marinet at their own convenience on the next working day¹ from 10 am onwards after vessel has been served. The information comprises the name of the vessel served, the date and timing of the service and bags of garbage disposed of. The initiative will commence on 1 Oct 2012.
- 3 Shipping agents and ship masters are advised to subscribe for a Marinet account (if you currently do not have one) to enjoy the benefits of the “E-receipt system”. Please refer to the webpage <https://marinet.mpa.gov.sg/index.jsp> for application of Marinet account procedures.
