Safety boats will be deployed to warn other craft to keep clear of the area.

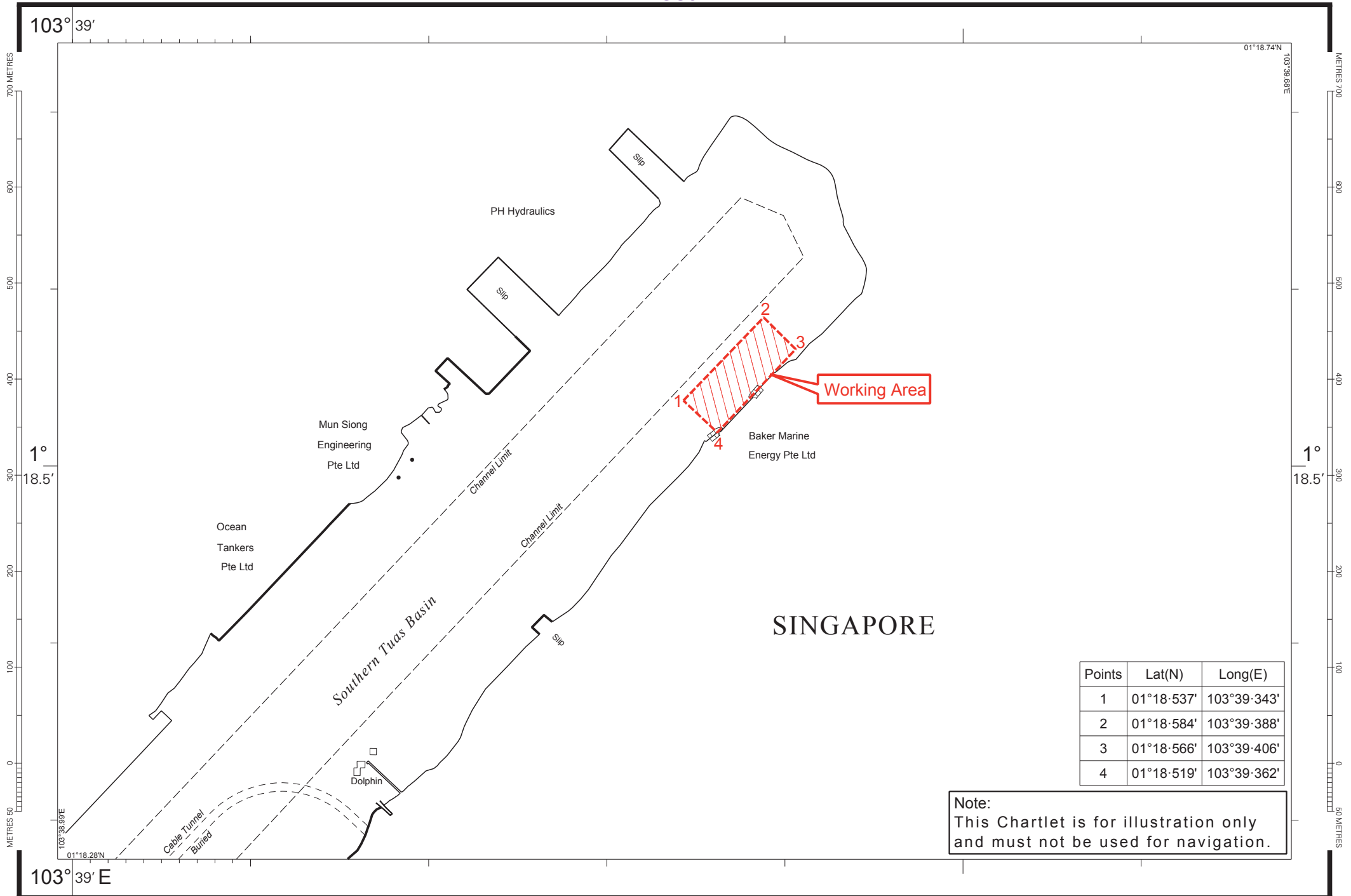

- e) **Communicate with Jurong Control on VHF Channel 22 for assistance, if required.**
