REPORTING OF CONTAINERS LOST AT SEA PURSUANT TO SOLAS REGULATIONS V/31 AND V/32, AS AMENDED

SOLAS regulations V/31 and V/32 were amended through resolution MSC.550(108) that was adopted on 23 May 2024, requiring shipmasters to communicate the observation of loss or drifting of freight container(s) by appropriate means without delay and to the fullest extent possible to ships in the vicinity and to the nearest coastal State and, to report the loss of container(s) to the flag State. The amendments to SOLAS regulation V/31 and V/32 are slated to enter into force on 01 January 2026.

- 2. Pursuant to the amendments to SOLAS regulations V/31 and V/32, Master of Singapore registered ship shall report the loss or drifting of freight container(s) to the nearest coastal State. To facilitate the reporting of the loss of container to the flag State, the Master or operator of Singapore registered ship shall use the reporting form in the Annex of this circular and submit to shipping@mpa.gov.sg.
