Description	÷	Salvage operations are being conducted for the sunken vessel 'Cai Jun 3' located at Latitude 1°25·915'N Longitude 104°27·389'E with least depth 12.6 metres below CD in the approaches to the west-bound lane of the Straits of Malacca and Singapore Routeing System at Horsburgh Lighthouse Area (STRAITREP Sector 9).
