3. Masters of vessel navigating within a **reporting[#]** sector are reminded of the following:
- (a) to keep a proper look-out for other vessels this may also be maneuvering within the area;
 - (b) to keep as near to the outer limit of the fairway which lies on her starboard side where it is safe and practicable;
 - (c) to proceed at a safe speed at all times;
 - (d) to comply with the International Regulation for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 as amended; and
 - (e) that anchoring is prohibited except in the case of emergency to avoid immediate danger.

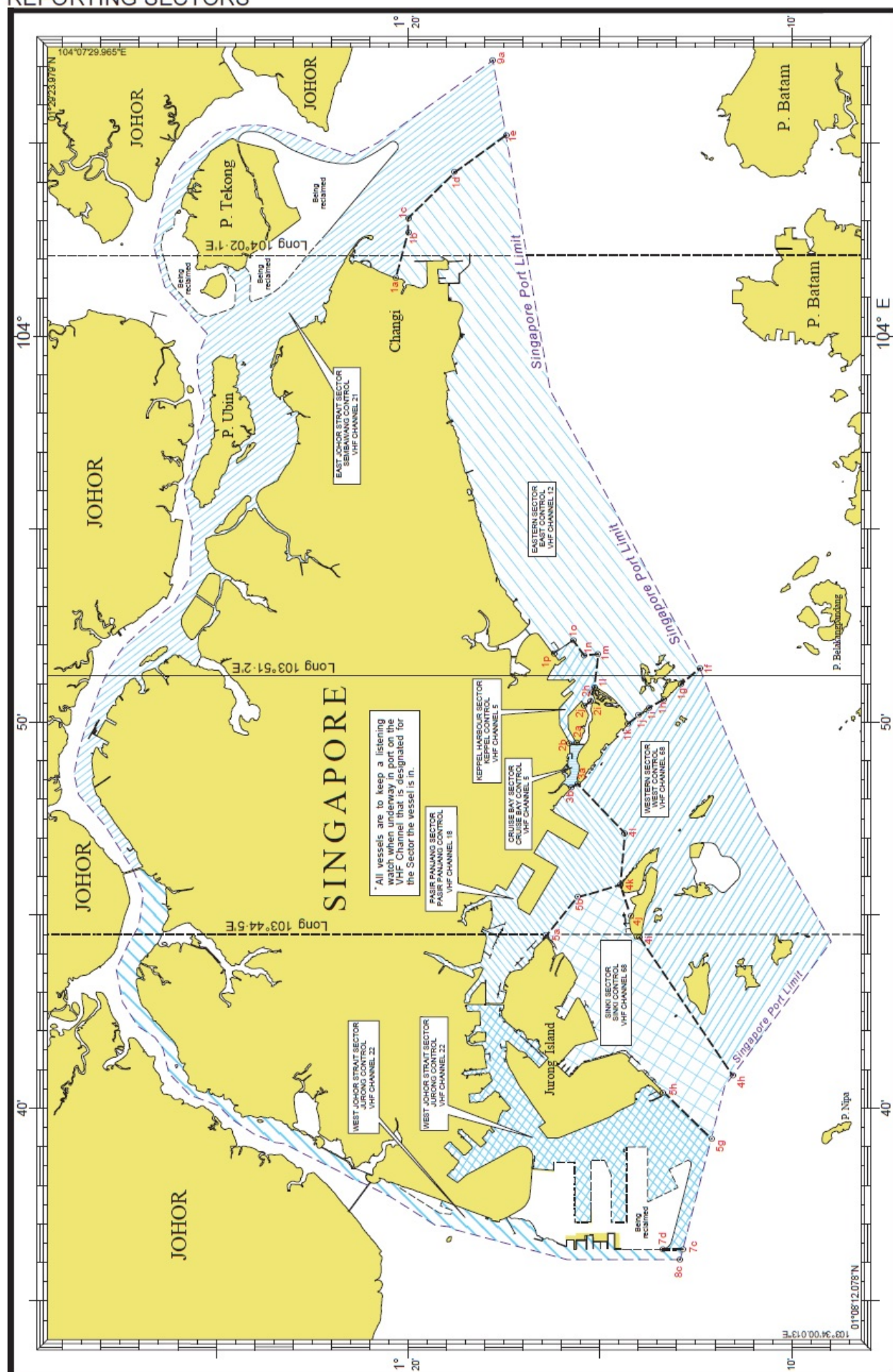
