*(NM 39T/2025) : SUNKEN VESSEL 'KSE HITACHI GO' OFF TUAS WESTERN COAST

Description

- 1. The sunken vessel 'KSE HITACHI GO' is located at position Lat 1°18·117'N Long 103°37·004'E.
- 2. A virtual AtoN (isolated danger mark) with MMSI no. 995636004 has been established at position Lat 1°18·125'N Long 103°36·945'E to mark the sunken vessel.
- 3. An isolated danger buoy, with light characteristics FI(2)10s, has also been established at the same position.
- 4. Mariners are advised to navigate with caution.
