Since its inception in 1996, MPA has been offering scholarships and sponsorships for degree and diploma studies to outstanding students. The degree scholarships are tenable at prestigious overseas and local universities, while the diploma sponsorships are tenable at the Singapore Maritime Academy in Singapore Polytechnic. Upon graduation, scholarship and sponsorship recipients can look forward to a challenging and varied career in MPA.

The Tripartite Maritime Scholarship Scheme (TMSS) and the Seafaring Alternative...An Investment For Life (SAIL) scholarships are jointly awarded by MPA, shipping companies, the Singapore Maritime Officers Union and the Singapore Organisation of Seamen. These awards are tenable at the Singapore Maritime Academy in Singapore Polytechnic and lead to a rewarding seafaring career. Scholars who wish to come onshore after a few years of seafaring experience would have ample opportunities awaiting them in light of their expertise and knowledge.

The MaritimeONE Scholarships were started in 2007 to prepare outstanding individuals for vibrant careers in Singapore’s thriving maritime ecosystem. Spearheaded by the Singapore Maritime Foundation and sponsoring maritime companies, the MaritimeONE Scholarships are a reflection of the industry’s commitment towards manpower development. Sponsoring companies provide the funding for these scholarships and also offer job opportunities in their companies for the scholars.
