ABOUT THE MARITIME YOUTH CLUB

The Maritime Youth Club (MYC) is an outreach initiative of MPA. Its main objective is to raise awareness of Maritime Singapore among the youths, who will be free to plan and initiate maritime-related activities that will meet their learning objectives. MYC members will also have opportunities to participate in the maritime industry and MPA's many outreach activities.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

MPA provides seed funding for schools to carry out maritime-related activities. To apply for MYC support, schools need to meet the following criteria:

- a. The school must be located in Singapore and registered under Singapore's Ministry of Education.
- b. The school should fall into one of the funding categories:
 - i. Primary/Secondary/Specialised Schools
 - ii. Post-Secondary institutions including Junior College/ITE/ Polytechnics/ Art Institutions (e.g. SOTA)
 - iii. Universities

The school must also carry out maritime-related activities under one of the following options:

- a. by setting up a dedicated Maritime Youth Club (MYC); or
- b. by integrating MYC activities as part of existing Co-Curricular Activities' (CCAs) workplans; or
- c. through the school's department/subject working committee(s).

FUNDING MODEL

MPA will disburse the relevant approved funding up to the maximum cap amount for the respective school level, based on their submitted proposal. Please see below for the annual funding limits for the various school levels.
