


WHAT IS MARITIME SINGAPORE?

Maritime Singapore is a flourishing network made up of maritime companies, organisations and people that drive all things maritime in Singapore. This network includes Singapore's global hub port, shipping and maritime services. It also includes the maritime companies, work force and agencies that help make sure Singapore stays competitive and favourable for businesses to set up and grow, since a large percentage of world trade is done by sea.



We have previously learnt that as a premier Global Hub Port, Singapore has a far-reaching network of connections to 600 ports in over 120 countries. We also learnt that as a leading International Maritime Centre, Singapore attracts many international maritime companies, with a wide range of maritime services made available to help maritime businesses such as maritime finance, insurance and law.

Maritime Singapore plays an important role in our lives because a lot of what we do and use is connected with the sea. Since the food we eat and the things we buy are mostly shipped to us by sea, the ability of the maritime network to work together is crucial to make sure that we are able to get what we need.



For example, the food and goods we need have to be packed into containers and loaded onto container ships in order to be sent to us. These containers will need to be loaded onto large container ships provided by shipping companies to take them from their port of origin to their destination port. Along the way, maritime services such as shipping finance, ship chartering and marine insurance will have to make sure these goods get delivered safely, timely and in the most costefficient way. Once these containers reach the port, port operators will have to quickly load and unload the containers onto trucks so that they can be delivered to warehouses, shops and eventually, your home.

Behind this thriving Maritime Singapore network are the people who work hard to make sure everything runs smoothly so that there are no interruptions. Today, there are more than 5,000 maritime establishments in Singapore, and more than 4,400 vessels registered

with the Singapore Registry of Ships. With the maritime industry contributing a significant amount of Singapore's economy, Maritime Singapore is an important and central part of Singapore's future development and growth as a maritime nation.


