

# Singapore Maritime Gallery

The Singapore Maritime Gallery would like all visitors to enjoy every moment of their time at the gallery. Please take a moment to read the following house rules which must be complied by all visitors in the interest of everyone's safety and comfort.

- Food and drinks are not permitted to be consumed in the gallery.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the gallery.
- Pets are not permitted in the gallery, apart from registered guide dogs.
- Items such as large bags, rucksacks and long umbrellas are not permitted in the exhibition areas. These items can be deposited near the reception counter. Strollers are to be folded up and deposited near the reception counter if the gallery is crowded.
- The gallery is accessible to wheelchair users. However, personal mobility devices such as electric scooters, skateboards etc. are not permitted in the gallery, and must be deposited near the reception counter.
- Photography, with no flash, can be taken in the gallery for personal use. For commercial photography, media photography and videography, prior arrangement is required.
- Visitors must observe basic rules of public conduct and etiquette, and should not behave in a manner that will disturb the experience of other visitors such as running, playing, talking loudly or shouting in the gallery.
- All persons-in-charge, teachers and supervisors of large groups must manage their groups' conduct and ensure that the group visits run smoothly.
- To ensure the safety and security of tour participants, the general public are not allowed to join pre-arranged tours that are being conducted. For the general public who wish to attend the gallery tour, kindly book online for the next available session.
- Visitors are liable for any intentional or accidental damages caused in the gallery and around its premises.
- There is camera surveillance throughout the gallery. The video recordings are kept for a period of time determined by the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) and may be made available to the police, if necessary.
- Photographs, videos and audio records may be taken of visitors at the gallery. By visiting the gallery, visitors grant the management of the gallery the full rights to use the resulting images and recordings without claims for payments or royalties for purposes that may include (but is not limited to) printed and online publicity, social media and media releases.
- MPA is not liable for any damage to, loss or theft of personal property.
