

Terms & Conditions of “Maritime Singapore in 2050” AI Image Contest

1. Definitions and interpretations

1.1. In these Terms and Conditions, unless the context otherwise requires, the following definitions apply:

- "Organiser" refers to the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (“MPA”), as the organiser of the “Maritime Singapore in 2050” AI Image contest (“Contest”).
- "Participant" refers to any individual, organisation, or entity making a submission for the Contest.
- "Entry" refers to the submission made by a Participant for the Contest.
- "Judging Panel" refers a group of personnel selected by the Organiser to evaluate Entries.
- "Winner" refers to a Participant who has been selected to receive a prize in the Contest.
- "Rules" refers to the terms and conditions set out herein.

2. Eligibility

2.1 The Contest is open to individuals and entities worldwide, with exception of excluded groups as cited in the Rules.

2.2 Employees of Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore are ineligible to participate.

3. Entries

3.1 Participants are invited to submit one original image for consideration in the contest. Each Entry must be in **JPEG or PNG** format, with a maximum file size of **10 MB** and a minimum resolution of **300 dpi**. Entries that do not meet these technical requirements may be disqualified.

3.2 Participants must include the following information in support of their Entry:

- a) AI platform used in the creation of their Entry;
- b) AI prompt or prompts used to generate or assist their Entry; and
- c) a brief description of their creative process and an explanation of how their work relates to the contest theme.

3.3 Each Participant may only make one Entry. Multiple entries from the same Participant are not allowed.

3.4 The submission window opens on **22 May 2026** and closes on **30 September 2026, 2359 hours**. Late Entries will not be accepted.

3.5 All Entries must comply with applicable copyright laws. Participants must ensure that their Submission does not infringe on the rights of any third party, including copyright, trademark, privacy, or publicity rights.

- 3.6 Entries shall not contain images or words that are harmful or defamatory, or images or words of a lewd, violent and/or malicious nature.
- 3.7 The Organiser reserves the right to reject any Entry that is incomplete, inaccurate, non-compliant, or otherwise deemed unsuitable for the Contest.
- 3.8 By submitting an Entry for the Contest, Participants agree that the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore, and the Government of Singapore, statutory agencies and Organs of State may use, distribute, reproduce, modify, adapt, publicly perform and publicly display any data, text, files, information, images, graphics, photos, and other content or materials (“Content”) that Participants submit, post, display or otherwise make available on this website, in any forum and for any purpose, which would include using such Content in any publicity materials for the website and in any medium (including the mass media, social media, internet posts, printed and e-mail communications and so on).
- 3.9 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or amend all or any part of the Contest and/ or Rules. Any changes to the Contest or Rules or will be posted on the Maritime Singapore Master Plan webpage (<https://www.mpa.gov.sg/maritime-singapore/MSMP>).
- 3.10 In event of any dispute regarding the Rules, conduct, or results of the Contest, the decision of the Organiser shall be final and incontestable.
- 3.11 By submitting an Entry for the Contest, the Participant agrees to comply with the Rules.

4. Judging Criteria

- 4.1 The following criteria will be used to assess Entries:
- a) **Creativity and originality**
The novelty of the idea, concept, or visual approach.
 - b) **Relevance to theme**
How clearly and effectively the image reflects the contest theme.
 - c) **Aesthetic appeal**
The strength of the image’s immediate appeal and ability to hold attention.
 - d) **Storytelling and explanation**
The clarity and strength of the participant’s description of their process and theme connection.
- 4.2 The Judging Panel will be made up of individuals selected by the Organiser to fairly evaluate all entries.

5. Winners

- 5.1 Winners will be notified via email.
- 5.2 Winners shall be required to:
- a) respond within the timeframe specified in the email;
 - b) follow all instructions and provide all information required; and

- c) comply with all instructions specified by the Organiser in relation to the prize redemption.

5.3 Failure to comply with the instructions in the email may result in disqualification.

5.4 List of Winners will be published on the Maritime Singapore Master Plan webpage (<https://www.mpa.gov.sg/maritime-singapore/MSMP>).

6. Use of Personal Data

6.1 Participants' personal data as provided in their Submissions will be collected, used, disclosed and/or processed by the Organiser for the following purposes:

- a) For purposes in connection with the Contest;
- b) For verification and record of the Participant's personal and using the information to communicate with the Participant; and
- c) To comply with any request from any third party or any order of court or directive from authorities investigating any alleged offence or misconduct or for the purposes of taking legal action against the Participant.
