**Re: Notice of temporary closure of Big Sister's Island and Jetty for repairs**

As part of National Parks Board's (NParks) cyclical inspection of the structures in our parks, our appointed Professional Engineer found the jetty at Big Sister's Island to be in need of repair. To ensure public safety, we will be closing Big Sister's Island to carry out jetty repair works starting from 10 April 2021, for a period of about six months. We seek the public's understanding for the inconvenience caused.
