Owners and Operators of Port Facilities

APPOINTMENT OF RECOGNISED SECURITY ORGANISATIONS (RSOs) FOR PORT FACILITIES

Port facilities as defined in Chapter XI-2 (Special Measures to Enhance Maritime Security) are required to comply with the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS Code) by 1 July 2004. These requirements will be incorporated as regulations in the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (Port) Regulations.

2 Port Facilities to which Chapter XI-2 applies are required to develop and maintain a port facility security plan (PFSP) on the basis of a port facility security assessment (PFSA) that is to be conducted by an authorised RSO. These port facilities are also required to designate port facility security officers and conduct drills / exercises in accordance with the ISPS Code.

3 The following organisations have been appointed as authorised RSOs for port facilities by MPA:

4 Owners/operators of port facilities are urged to take the necessary action as soon as possible to engage an appointed RSO for conducting the PFSA. Port facilities that have 'in-house capabilities' may conduct the PFSA on their own. However, the assessment will be required to be verified and endorsed by an appointed RSO prior to submission to MPA for approval. Port facilities may also engage these RSOs for developing their PFSP.

5 When the PFSA and PFSP have been approved, a port facility will be issued with a 'Statement of Compliance of a Port Facility' (SoCPF), which will be valid for 5

years. In addition, port facilities are required to engage the services of the RSOs to carry out verification audit every two and a half years.
