### **DANGERS OF DIRECTING LASER LIGHTS AT AIRCRAFT**

- 1 This notice is intended to highlight the dangers of directing laser lights at an aircraft.
- 2 Directing of laser lights at aircraft can be hazardous to their operations. The lights can confuse, distract or cause discomfort to pilots on the aircraft.
